RRB ALP Psycho Test Syllabus 2025 – Selection Process

The RRB ALP selection process has the following stages:

- 1. CBT 1 General Intelligence, Maths, Science, GK
- CBT 2 Part A (Mathematics, General Intelligence and Reasoning, Basic Science and Engineering), Part B (Relevant Trade)
- 3. CBAT Computer Based Aptitude Test, also known as Psycho Test (Only for ALP posts)

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4. Document Verification & Medical

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The Psycho Test (CBAT) is only for candidates who have cleared CBT 2 and have applied for the ALP post.

RRB ALP Psycho Test Syllabus 2025 – What is Psycho Test in ALP

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The CBAT (Computer Based Aptitude Test) is designed to test your speed, decision-making skills, presence of mind, memory, and the ability to follow orders or instructions – all of which are crucial for a Loco Pilot.

Unlike CBT 1 & 2, the Psycho Test doesn't check your academic knowledge. Instead, it simulates real-life railway scenarios to assess how efficiently and accurately you can react under pressure.

RRB ALP Psycho Test Syllabus 2025 – Section-wise Breakdown

Here's the complete CBAT syllabus as per the RDSO pattern followed by RRBs:

1. Memory Test

Tests your ability to memorize numbers, patterns, symbols, or colour combinations.

There are total 5 Types in Memory Test

- 1. House (Building) Memory Test (*Question*: 12 + 12 = 24) (*Time*: 4 + 4 = 8 Minutes)
- 2. Picture Number or (Figure Digit) Memory Test (Question: 21 + 21 = 42) (Time: 6 + 6 = 12 Minutes)
- 3. Railway Track Memory Test (Question: 12 + 12 = 24) (Time: 5 + 5 = 10 Minutes)
- 4. Picture to Picture (Figure to Figure) Memory Test (*Question*: 20 + 20 = 40) (*Time*: 6 + 6 = 12 Minutes)
- 5. Object (12 Figure) Memory Test (Question: 12 + 12 = 24) (Time: 5 + 5 = 10 Minutes)

2. Following Directions Test

Assesses your ability to follow complex instructions quickly and accurately.

There are Total 3 Types in Following Direction Test

- 1. Alphabetic Type Table Test (Question: 10) (Time: 5 Minutes)
- 2. Numeric Type Table Test (*Question*: 10) (*Time*: 5 Minutes)
- 3. Watch (Clock) Table Test (Question: 20) (Time: 10 Minutes)

3. Depth Perception Test

Evaluates your skill in judging distances between objects.

There are total 2 Types in Depth Perception Test

- 1. Bricks Test (*Question*: 10 x 5 = 50) (*Time*: 5 Minutes)
- 2. Hidden Cube Test (Question: 50) (Time: 10 Minutes)

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4. Test of Power of Observation

Measures your attention span and speed of response.

There are total 4 Types in Power of Observation Test

- 1. Yes and No Test (Question: 96) (Time: 4 Minutes)
- 2. Find Digit 6 Test (Question: 75) (Time: 4 Minutes)
- 3. Find Digit 9 Test (Question: 75) (Time: 4 Minutes)
- 4. Picture Placement Positioning Test or Figure Replacement Test (Question: 75) (Time: 4 Minutes)

5. Perceptual Speed Test

Tests how quickly and accurately you can identify differences or match patterns.

There are total 4 Types in Perceptual Speed Test

- 1. Similarity Test (Question: 18 x 4 = 72) (Time: 6 Minutes)
- 2. Same Figure (Hexagonal) Test (*Question*: 96) (*Time*: 6 Minutes)
- 3. Same Figure (Octagonal) Test (*Question*: 96) (*Time*: 6 Minutes)
- 4. Same Figure (Circle) Test (Question: 96) (Time: 6 Minutes)

These modules are computer-based and time-bound. Practicing each module thoroughly is key to qualifying.

RRB ALP Psycho Test Syllabus 2025 – Marking Scheme, Qualifying Criteria

Here are the official details every aspirant must know:

- Minimum Qualifying Marks: You must score at least 42 T-Score in each test battery. This is fixed no relaxation based on category.
- No Negative Marking
- Final Merit Calculation:
- 1. 70% weightage to CBT 2 Part A
- 2. 30% weightage to CBAT (Psycho Test)

If you fail to score 42 T Score in even one section, you will be disqualified - irrespective of your overall score.
